



**AQUANIMA COOKIE POLICY**

## **1. Responsible entity**

By way of this notice, IBÉRICA DE COMPRAS CORPORATIVAS, S.L., a Spanish company with registered address at Avda. De Cantabria S/N, Edificio Arrecife, Planta 0, 28660 Boadilla del Monte, Madrid, with Tax ID number B-82797713 and registered in the Mercantile Registry of Madrid volume 15,946, Book 0, Section 8, page M-269630, and owner of *this website* ("AQUANIMA" or the "Editor", indistinctly), informs the users of the website [www.aquanima.com](http://www.aquanima.com) ("the Website" and "the User or the Users") about its Cookie Policy, so that they understand the cookies that will be used while they browse the Website and can consent to their use

This Cookie Policy (the "Cookie Policy") is supplemented by this website's privacy policy in all relevant matters.

## **2. What are cookies?**

Cookies are files that are downloaded and stored on the devices (computer/smartphone/tablet) of users who browse the Internet when they access some websites and applications. They are used to store and retrieve information about the browsing from that device.

Cookies can be installed either directly by the websites visited or by third parties with which the website has some kind of connection. The website uses the cookies to keep track of the user's activity on the site and others connected with it, for example: the location from which it is accessed, the connection time, the device from which it is accessed (fixed or mobile), the operating system and browser used, the most visited websites, the number of clicks and data on the user's browsing habits.

## **3. What cookies does this Website use and for what purpose?**

This Website uses the following types of cookies:

**3.1. Strictly necessary cookies inserted by the Editor and technical cookies:** the Editor inserts both types of cookies in the Website and accesses the information to provide services requested by the user and to ensure the technical operation of the Website respectively. As the name indicates, these are necessary to provide the service and the service cannot be provided if they are disabled.

Pursuant to art. 22.2 of the ISESA (Information Society Services and Electronic Commerce Act), users do not have to give their consent for them to be used.

These cookies do not enable us to identify the user unambiguously.

The table below provides more in-depth information about these cookies.

**3.2. Third-party cookies:** the types of third party cookies that may be downloaded to the User's device when using the Website that are sent by a domain or device managed by a third party other than the Editor, or which are inserted by the Editor but the information from which is processed by a third party, are described below, according to their purpose. These cookies do not enable the Editor to identify the users who browse its website. Information collected by third parties using these cookies is subject to their privacy policies.

**3.2.1. Analysis cookies:** these cookies enable the Editor to track and analyse the behaviour of users when they browse its website and use its services. The Editor uses them to measure the activity on the website and create browsing profiles that enable it to make improvements based on analysis of usage data. The information handled does not allow the user to be identified uniquely.

**This Website uses Google Analytics** to analyse how Users use the Website. These cookies collect anonymous information about how visitors use the website to enable the Editor to improve the User's experience.

These cookies do not collect identifiable personal information about the visitor. The information collected by these cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous. These cookies are only used to improve website performance. Please visit the Google Privacy Centre and the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on web pages for more information about how cookies work and how to disable them.

#### **4. What is the legal ground for the use of cookies?**

Except in the case of strictly necessary and technical cookies, which we have already explained above, the Editor will only insert cookies into your device (the user's device) with your prior consent.

You may give your consent by clicking "Accept all cookies" or by adjusting the settings for those cookies to which you freely consent through the cookie settings panel displayed by the Editor the first time you access the Website.

#### **5. Can you withdraw your consent?**

Once the cookies have been installed, the user may choose to revoke their consent and delete them at any time. Users can do this using the content and privacy settings available in their browser while browsing the website.
